1. D-Day and Liberation Tour of Europe 2025

The WVSS Social Studies department has planned an exciting learning opportunity for students in Grade 10-12 from April 24-May 5, 2025, and **there are still a few spots remaining!**

May 2025 marks the 80th anniversary of the liberation of the Netherlands by Canadian forces in WWII. The trip will follow in the footsteps of Canadian soldiers who were instrumental in the success of the liberation of Europe from Nazi occupation. The tour begins in London, followed by travel by sea from Portsmouth to Normandy, France, where students will visit significant historical sites such as Dieppe, Juno beach, and Dunkirk, while staying in the coastal town of Honfleur. They will then travel to Bruges, Belgium and finish in the Netherlands, visiting sites such as the Anne Frank House in Amsterdam and the Airborne Museum in Arnhem. Students will take part in a ceremony recognizing the Canadian contribution to Dutch liberation on May 4th, 2025. The tour also includes visits to popular sites such as Buckingham Palace, Camden Market and the canals of Amsterdam.
