They competed earlier this month in the **Canadian CyberTitan Cybersecurity National Finals** (<https://ictc-ctic.ca/news-and-events/news-articles/ictc-cybertitan-13-student-teams-progress-national-cybersecurity>).

The students did exceptionally well....they ranked **FIRST** amongst all teams from Western Canada, and **SECOND** amongst all Canadian teams. This is the **first time, EVER**, that a BC team has ranked in the top 5.
