IF families need to update their address, please note that the required documents are as follows:

1. One Primary Proof of Residence: Property tax notice (current year), BC Assessment (current year), Tenancy agreement, Property purchase agreement

AND

2. One Utility Bill showing the new service address on: BC Hydro, Fortis, Cable, or other metered utility

OR

Three Supplemental Documents: Tenant insurance, Mobile phone bill, ICBC registration/insurance certificate, BC Driver's License, BCID, or BC Services Card, Credit card or bank statement, Community membership card
