TOBACCO-FREE ENVIRONMENT

Background

The District recognizes tobacco use presents a danger to the health of students and adults and that there is a province-wide tobacco ban on all public school property

Procedures

- 1. There will be no use of tobacco on any West Vancouver School District property, within any West Vancouver School District building, or within any Board owned or leased vehicle.
- 2. All school grounds, buildings and vehicles shall be non-smoking areas at all times, including evenings and weekends.
- 3. Smoking is prohibited in all vehicles used to transport students for school activities.
- 4. All schools shall include the School District's and school's expectations regarding tobacco use in their Code of Conduct.
- 5. All schools are required to have signage indicating the ban on tobacco use on school grounds and property.
- 6. Instruction on the hazards of tobacco use will be provided for students in the elementary and secondary schools.
- 7. The only exemption to the District Tobacco-Free Environment Procedure shall be the approved ceremonial use of tobacco with recognized ceremonies.
