WEST VANCOUVER SCHOOLS PREMIER ROBOTICS ACADEMY

The Concept

The Mechatronics Robotics Academy is a choice program offered to students, Grades 9-12, who are registered full time at any of the district's public secondary schools: Rockridge, Sentinel Secondary or West Vancouver Secondary.

The program offers students the opportunity to explore their potential in Competitive Robotics as a way of using STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) skills in a practical and handson environment.

Students work in design teams, in a variety of roles to research, build, program and test robots, ultimately competing in robotics competitions locally, provincially, and internationally.

There are local tournaments, usually 5 per year, occurring all day on Saturdays. There are provincial championships for teams who qualify. Teams who compete successfully also have the opportunity to qualify for the world championships.

The Schedule

The Mechatronics Robotics Academy classroom sessions occur during X Block periods all year long (linearly) within the West Vancouver Schools Semester System.

- X Block period: Tuesday from 1:20 4:00 p.m. all year long OR
- X Block period: Thursday from 1:20 4:00 p.m. all year long OR

*For senior students who my have conflicts with their schedules: Friday, 3:30 – 6:10 p.m. Please note that the Academy staff determine the day for students as the decisions are based on several factors such as student teams and academic timetable conflicts.

Courses

By participating in the Mechatronics Robotics Academy, students (9-12) receive the following Ministry course depending upon the student grade level:

Grade 9:ADST Electronics & Robotics 9Grade 10:ADST Electronics & Robotics 10Grade 11:Robotics 11Grade 12:Robotics 12

For students, Grades 10-12, there is also the opportunity to earn additional course credits based on the students' skill level, ability to complete extra work for an additional course and the consistent ability to participate in many additional hours.

*Students who request the additional courses must be approved by the Robotics Academy teachers. More information is provided within the month of September to confirm this additional opportunity based on many factors.

Clothing/Equipment

We want our students to feel welcomed and a member of a team. To create this positive environment among students, we would like students to uniformly dressed. Once registration is complete, parents will be informed & provided an online link (May/June) that outlines the process to order the mandatory & optional clothing items in order to receive the orders for school start-up. Parents will also be provided with a deadline date when all online orders must be completed.

Transportation

The Mechatronics Robotics Academy classroom sessions take place in a wing of West Vancouver Secondary School. Transportation is provided one-way for students from both Rockridge Secondary and Sentinel Secondary. Students board the buses out front of their respective schools. Parents are responsible for picking up the students at the end of the sessions.

Process for Registration Completion

The student application is reviewed by the robotics academy staff and then parents are informed by the Academy Office.

Once parents receive student confirmation of acceptance into the academy, parents will receive the applicable forms to be completed.

Parents complete the registration process by providing a non-refundable deposit of \$275 on the student's School Cash Online account or by submitting a cheque made payable to West Vancouver Schools with the current date. This non-refundable deposit covers September's fees and confirms the student's registration.

Please note that Academy fees for October to June will be processed through School Cash Online enabling parents to initiate automated monthly payments via credit card or direct debit.
