
General Concept

- Students also accepted from any one of the schools in the North Vancouver School District

The Program - Youth Train in Trades

CARPENTRY

- Provides technical training for students interested in a career in carpentry or related trades
- Hands-on, real-life work experience
- Small cohort of approx. 16 students
- Students can receive credit for Level
 1 Carpentry from high school





Why Apply for this Program?

- Students graduate from their current high school
- Students are knowledgeable, skilled and ready to enter a career that is in big demand!
- The fees associated with this program are MINIMAL compared to students completing this same program - post-secondary

The Location




The "home" of the program is at West Vancouver Secondary School

 Genuine interest or passion – sound reasons for applying Commitment to participate for the full school year Complete the student on-line registration form for the district program Submission of most recent report card □ References for courses and work habits relevant to the program Show evidence or answers within the completed registration form: Ability to work cooperatively Demonstrated good character: being responsible & respectful Ability to work well with others Ability to listen, to follow instructions and rules, as well as adhere to health & safety protocols





Next Steps

Register on-line at westvancouverschools.ca
Ensure the student is registered full time at any one of our West Vancouve Schools secondary schools (RO, SE or WVSS OR we also accept applicants registered in a school on the North Shore
Submit the most recent report card
Participate in an assessment. Parents whose students have completed the on-line registration will be informed of the date/time of the interview.
Complete the process for final registration (non-refundable deposit)
Parents whose students are confirmed for the program will receive ongoing communication about the process to be ready for September 2021
