

Facility Rentals Spring 2021 Covid-19 Update

West Vancouver Schools will be providing limited rentals beginning on March 29th. In balancing access with our need to keep our facilities safe during pandemic conditions, at this time West Vancouver Schools will only be permitting rentals in the evening (5pm – 9pm) on weekdays, and on weekends between 9am and 4pm, at a limited number of our schools gymnasiums:

- Caulfeild Elementary
- Eagle Harbour Montessori
- Ecole Pauline Johnson
- Rockridge Secondary School
- West Vancouver Secondary School South Campus

The Licensee must comply with all applicable health and safety laws, regulations, orders, directives, guidelines and recommendations of the federal, provincial, municipal, regulatory and courts having jurisdiction relating to the global Covid-19 pandemic.

The Licensee must have a Covid-19 Safety Plan in place that complies with all Provincial Health Authority orders relevant to their program, as required by the Provincial Health Officer. The Licensee must abide by this plan throughout the course of their rental activities while on West Vancouver Schools sites, including following all rules, protocols and orders with respect to both their individual plan and general federal and provincial Covid-19 health and safety requirements. The Licensee is responsible for providing all hand hygiene products and personal protection equipment deemed necessary under their Covid-19 safety plan.

The Licensee will be responsible for providing the contact information of their program participants to the Health Authorities, should it become necessary.

West Vancouver Schools may not be held liable should any participant in a Licensee's program contract Covid-19.

Sport organizations must follow the <u>return to sport guidelines</u> and follow the <u>Provincial Health</u> <u>Officer orders.</u>

BC's Back to School Plan

"Extracurricular activities including sports, arts and special interest clubs can only occur if:

- Physical distance can be maintained between members of different learning groups
- Reduced physical contact is practiced by those within the same learning group"

"All youth indoor and outdoor sport for youth 21 and younger must follow <u>viaSport's Return to Sport Phase 2 quidance</u> with respect to maintaining physical distance for participants. This means games, tournaments and competitions are temporarily suspended but individual drills and modified training can continue. No spectators are allowed for sports activities."

In order to meet the Health & Safety Protocols referenced above, West Vancouver Schools may incur additional custodial costs resulting from the rental of space beyond regular school hours. Licensees will be charged on a cost recovery basis for any such incremental costs.
