





Clothing or Equipment Requirements



- Students are required to purchase the official Premier Basketball Academy gear consisting of a reversible jersey and shorts

Other optional items include:

- Shooter shirt
- Backpack

- Clothing sales are purchased online through the Time Out Sports online store

- More information will be provided to parents and students once accepted into the academy

Fees

Fee: \$2000 (\$200 per month x 10 months)

September to June

After the try-out, once students are confirmed for the academy, parents will be required to submit a deposit to hold the student's spot

Academy programs have implemented School Cash Online for collection of fees





The Selection Process

Selection Process & Criteria

- Genuine interest or passion – sound reasons for applying
- Complete and submit the online Student Information Form indicating why they would be a good candidate for the academy
- Submit with the registration form a copy of the student's most recent report card
- Participate in a try-out (date/s to be confirmed)
- Once selected, a commitment to participate for the full school year
- The criteria for selection also includes students who (through the report card) demonstrate:
 - Being responsible & respectful
 - Ability to work well with others
 - Ability to follow the rules of the academy
 - Ability to adhere to ongoing mandatory Health & Safety protocols

Basketball Try-Out Information

There are basketball try-outs for all four co-horts

Boys Development

For boys currently in Grades 7 or 8

Boys RTC 1 & 2

For boys currently in Grades 9, 10, & 11

Girls RTC

For girls currently in Grades 7-11

All try-out sessions will take place at West Vancouver Secondary School in the gymnasium

Parents are to register their students online completing the Student Information Form

Parents will be contacted regarding the dates & times of the try-outs



Next Steps

- Ensure the student is registered full time a West Vancouver School District secondary school: Ecole Sentinel, Rockridge or West Vancouver Secondary.

- Register on-line at westvancouver.schools.ca & complete the Student Information Form
*Student's most recent report card must be uploaded with the application.
- Participate in the basketball try-out. Parents whose students have completed the on-line registration will be informed of the date/time of the try-out date.
- Parents whose students are confirmed for the program will receive ongoing communication about the paperwork and final process in order to be ready for September 2022.
