# 1. Excellence Through Recruitment

# 2. Recruitment Initiatives

Custodians who held supplemental COVID-related positions have been shifted to casual status. A part-time EA to support deaf and hard of hearing students has been recruited and Lance Gallagher has replaced retiring Kathleen Scott as the district's a full-time electrician. Recruitment continues for casual office support clerks and Education Assistants. Practicum students have been secured to work with the IT team, the International department, the SBO and at Rockridge Secondary. Partnerships and recruitment efforts such as career fairs and information sessions with Capilano University, UBC and Langara College were highlighted.

### 3. Health & Safety Update

All sites and schools have held Joint Health & Safety Committee meetings to review the updated Provincial COVID Communicable Disease k-12 Guidelines and complete a COVID Checklist. Health and safety initiatives are planned for the May Professional Development Day. A standard first aid that includes CPR and AED training will be offered as well as a refresher session to clerical employees on H&S reporting processes and WorkSafeBC regulations.

The BC Employment Standards Act (ESA) was recently changed to provide up to 5 days of paid sick time for employees not eligible for paid sick leave through the collective agreement. This legislation will apply to casual, temporary support staff employees and Teachers Teaching on Call immediately.
