West Vancouver Secondary School was founded in 1927 and enjoys being on 17 acres of property with 2 campuses. We serve students in grades 8-12 with a dual track system offering the BC Dogwood Diploma and the IB Diploma Programme (authorized in 1988). WVSS focuses on academic excellence and an extensive elective offerings. We are a modern facility with an onsite Robotics Academy, 2 state of the art theatres, art and graphic design studios and a dance studio.

WVSS provides academic rigour which prepares our students for their post-secondary lives. 90% of our graduates proceed directly to universities or colleges locally, nationally and internationally. And each year our graduates receive and win university entrance scholarships.

For early decision, WVSS will submit the student's WVSS transcript from Grades 9-11, along with current IBDP predicted grades. In late November, first semester interim Grade 12 BC Diploma grades will also be submitted with updated IB predicted marks.

BC Secondary School - Dogwood Diploma:

The B.C. Certificate of Graduation or "Dogwood Diploma" is awarded to students who successfully complete the provincial graduation requirements.

Students require a minimum of 80 credits to graduate. Of these 80 credits:

- At least 16 credits must be at the Grade 12 level, including a required Language Arts 12
- At least 28 credits must be elective course credits

52 credits are required from the following:

- Career-Life Education (4 credits), and Career-Life Connections (4 credits)
- Physical and Health Education 10 (4 credits)

- Science 10 (4 credits), and a Science 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- Social Studies 10 (4 credits), and a Social Studies 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- A Math 10 (4 credits), and a Math 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- A Language Arts 10, 11 and a required 12 (12 credits total)
- An Arts Education 10, 11, or 12 and/or an Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies 10, 11, or 12 (4 credits total)

In addition, students will have completed Grade 10 Graduation Numeracy Assessment and Grade 10 Literacy Assessment

The School Calendar

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, WVSS has adopted a semester system for the 2021-2022 school year. The purpose of this schedule is to reduce contacts in the school.

Semester 1: September 7 – January 31

Semester 2: February 1 - June 22

There are two official reporting periods, at the end of each semester. There is also a mid-term report each semester. Classes meet five days a week for approximately sixteen weeks each semester. Students take four classes per semester. Three classes are 80 minutes in length and the fourth is 1 hour and 15 minutes long. Year-long classes are available and are scheduled two afternoons a week. Grades for these classes are reported three times during the year.
