What are WVS Premier District Programs?

These are choice programs with a fee associated with them

Designed as areas of interest, strength or passion for students in our West Vancouver Schools

Taught by WVS teachers, but can include partnerships with outside community members

Students receive courses/credits towards graduation

The Program – Youth Train in Trades CARPENTRY

- Provides technical training for students interested in a career in carpentry or related trades
- Hands-on, real-life work experience
- Small cohort of approx. 16 students
- Students can receive credit for Level 1 Carpentry from high school





Why Apply for this Program?

- Students graduate from their current high school
- Students are knowledgeable, skilled and ready to enter a career that is in big demand!
- The fees associated with this program are MINIMAL compared to students completing this same program - post-secondary



The Schedule

- Ensure the student is registered full time at any one of our West Vancouver Schools secondary schools (RO, SE or WVSS OR we also accept applicants registered in a school on the North Shore)
- **u** Submit the most recent report card
- Participate in an assessment. Parents whose students have completed the on-line registration will be informed of the date/time of the interview.
- □ Complete the process for final registration (non-refundable deposit)
- Parents whose students are confirmed for the program will receive ongoing communication about the process to be ready for January 2023
