

WEST VANCOUVER SCHOOLS PREMIER VOLLEYBALL ACADEMY

The Concept

West Vancouver Schools is running a linear system which allows the students to complete their academic courses in the morning and then the ability to participate in the Premier Volleyball Academy in the afternoon.

This is one of the district's special programs for students Grades 8-12 who are registered full time at any one of the district's three secondary schools: Rockridge, École Sentinel or West Vancouver Secondary.

Clothing/Equipment

We would like students to be uniformly dressed. The clothing includes such items as t-shirts, shorts, and a water bottle. Optional items are also available such as long-sleeved shirts and hoodies.

Once registration is complete, parents will be informed & provided an online link (May/June) to order the mandatory & optional clothing items with the goal of receiving the orders in time for school start-up. Parents will also be provided with a date when all online orders must be completed.

Transportation

Early Morning Co-Hort

Afternoon Co-Hort

Transportation is provided one-way for students at both Rockridge & Sentinel. Students board the buses out front of their respective schools. Parents are responsible for picking up the students at the end of the training sessions (e.g., 3:00 p.m.)

Fees

Section B: Afternoon

Time: 1:30 – 3:00 p.m.

Fee: \$275 per month x 10 months (\$2750)

Process for Registration Completion

Complete & submit a Student Information Form to the Premier Volleyball Academy at: <https://westvancouver.schools.ca/academies/volleyball> Please ensure the student's most recent report card is uploaded with the application.

The student application is then reviewed by the coaching staff.

Current students & potential new students participate in an on-court assessment. Students & parents are informed from the Academy Office the results of the assessment.

Once parents receive student confirmation of acceptance into the academy, parents complete the necessary paperwork:

- Physical Activity (Par-Q & You)

- Waiver
- Health & Safety

Once parents are confirmed, they complete the registration process by providing a non-refundable deposit of \$275 OR \$200 depending upon the Co-Hort (e.g., early morning OR afternoon) via School Cash Online. This non-refundable deposit covers September's fees and holds the student's spot in the program.

Please note that Academy fees from October to June will also be processed through School Cash Online enabling parents to initiate automated monthly payments via credit card or direct debit.
