Coming soon: West Vancouver Schools Early Childhood Education Centre

West Vancouver Schools is proudly creating 116 new child care spaces for our community!

Thanks to the generous support from the provincial and federal governments through the ChildCareBC New Spaces Fund, West Vancouver Schools will soon break ground on a state-of-the-art child care centre. This facility will reflect our ongoing commitment to educational excellence and our mission to create a 'world of opportunity' for all students. We are excited to extend this mission to our youngest learners ages 0-5 years in our new child care centre.

Owned and operated by the West Vancouver School District, this new centre will increase opportunities for families seeking high quality educational care for young children aligning with our community's <u>Child Care Action Plan</u>. In addition to becoming a centre of excellence for child care and early learning, this new community space will provide outreach services for families including parent learning opportunities, family connections and supports.

The **West Vancouver Schools Early Childhood Education Centre** will create 116 child care spaces:

- 36 spaces for infant-toddlers,
- 50 spaces for 30 months to kindergarten,
- 30 spaces for school-age care on school grounds.

The centre will be located on school district property on 22nd Street, next to École Pauline Johnson. This location was selected carefully due to its central location to community amenities, public transportation and ease of access for the families of West Vancouver.

We are proud to be working with a team of esteemed professional consultants – namely, Iredale Architecture and NUQO Modular to bring this vision to life.
