

Parent Student Learning Survey Results

- Does your child have opportunities to participate in any Indigenous celebrations or activities?

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(Don't Know – 42%; No - 30%; 27% Yes)
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- Does school make your child feel stressed or anxious?
 (Yes 68%)
- Is your child learning emotional self-regulation? (Yes 71%)
- At school, is your child able to get extra academic help when needed? (Yes – 87%)





Parent Student Learning Survey Results

Do you see diverse orientations and gender identities represented in your child's school? (Yes -76%)

Is your child given opportunities to make a difference in their community (for example, by volunteering with local organizations)? (Yes – 78%)

Do you think the BC education system is preparing students for transitions to the **work-force** after graduation? (No - 50%)

Do you feel welcome at your child's school? (Yes - 90%)
