

Framework for Enhancing Student Learning

Aligns with the ATL **Self-Management Skills** (Affective and Organizational skills) and **Social Skills** (Leadership) of the MYP

We will work on developing students who:

- take ownership of their choices and actions;
- set and monitor goals;
- are organized;
- care for themselves by managing stress; and
- contribute respectfully and care for the environment.

To build on the palpable enthusiasm in all areas of school life that contribute to a positive school culture




